



THE PASTA TOWER CHALLENGE

DESIGN GUIDELINES

Below are guidelines to keep in mind when making your Pasta Tower submission. We encourage participation first and foremost, so remember that you won't be disqualified if your entry doesn't comply with every guideline, but if you do, your entry will score higher!

GOOD LUCK!

Per the contest rules, you may submit up to 6 images/photos (up to 3 MB each), title, and text description of your final Pasta Tower design. This is what we hope to see:

- A tower made using store-bought SPAGHETTI. Not Linguini, not fettucini, not homemade, super-charged pasta. You are welcome to break the 50 spaghetti pieces into smaller pieces if wanted.
- A tower made using store-bought mini-marshmallows. You are welcome to smush, divide, combine or do whatever you want with them.
- Text explanation of how your tower design was engineered, including any unique design approaches.
- Photo showing your whole pasta tower top to bottom.
- Photo showing the top of your tower next to a ruler, tape measure or measuring stick showing its measured height.
- Detail photos of your design that complement your text description explanation.
